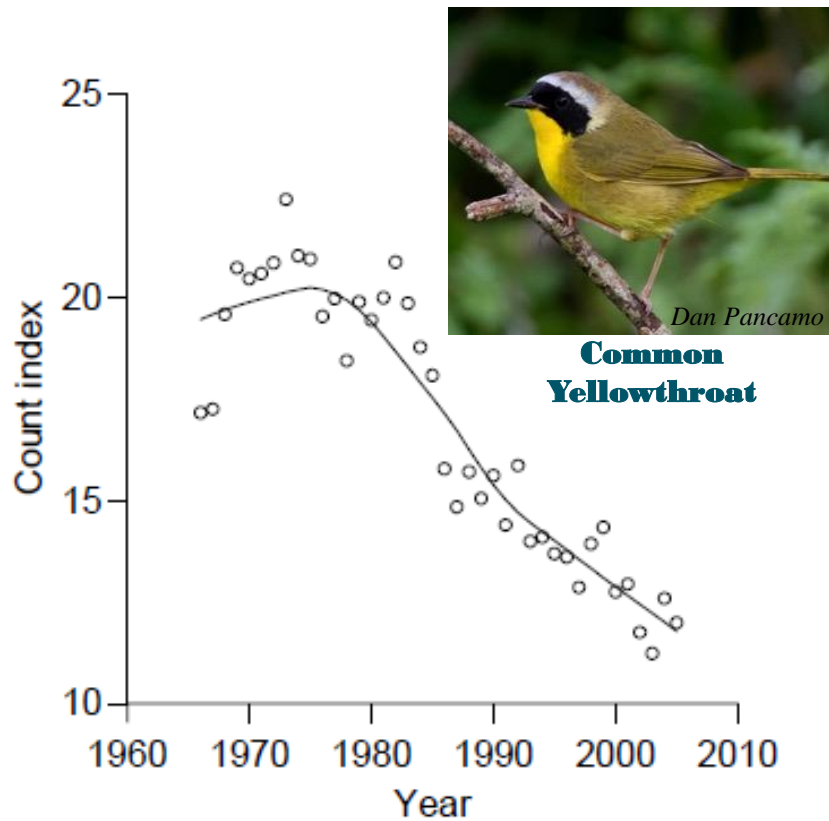

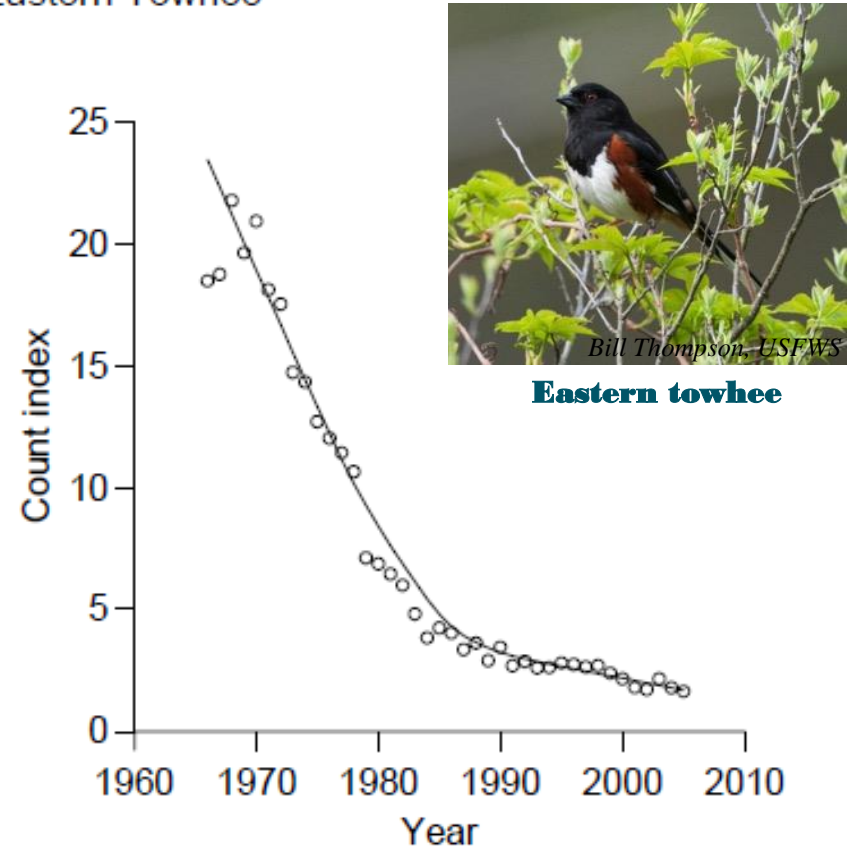

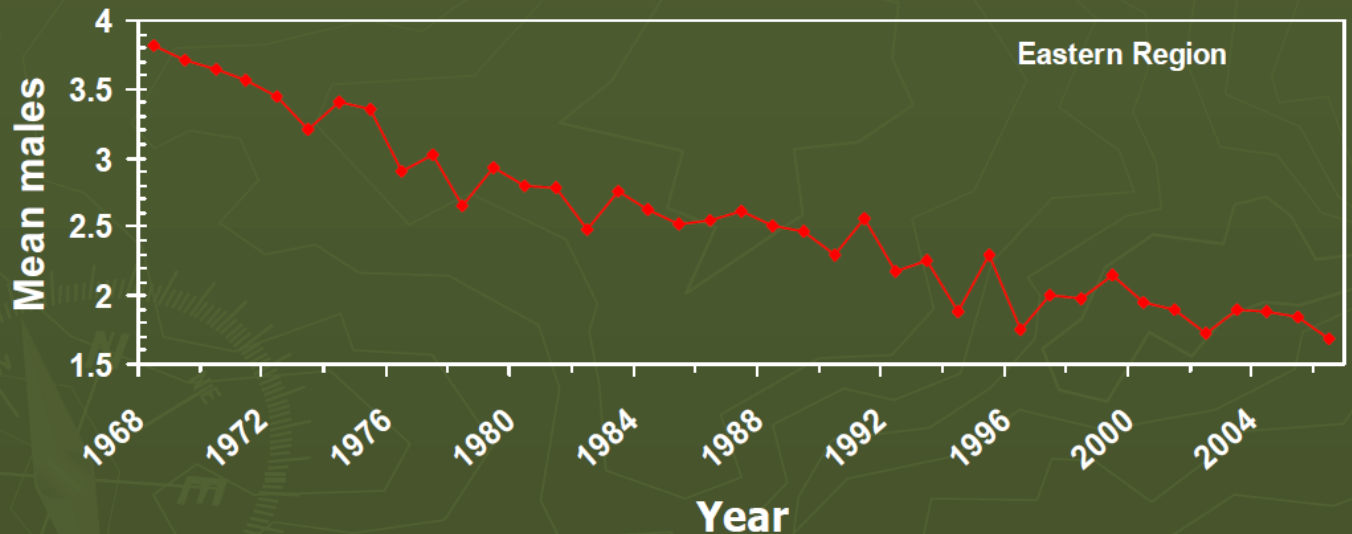

Managing Disturbance

- What constitutes disturbance?
- Landscape scale/fragmentation/edges
- Soil conditions—pH, bacterial vs. fungal systems, structure, seed banks, germination conditions, moisture, fertility, erosion...
- Understand plant lifecycles and plant and wildlife community dynamics
- Structural diversity leads to wildlife diversity
- Diversity = Resilience
